Fremont Twp Meeting Notes

- FIRE
 - Pumper/Tender 520 is being worked on currently, quoted price for the water leak was \$800.00. Hopefully it will be done in the next couple of weeks.
 - Received the 4 SCBA and 10 communications systems for the SCBA and they are installed. We will do some training on them in November and December to become familiar with them.
 - The members were able to run several of the water lines in the old station. There is some more work before we can tie it all together.
 - We had two fire calls, one for a false alarm activation and the other for a pin-in injury accident.
 - We have found several pickups and some full truck and box combinations on multiple sites. The chief requested to set a price that would be available to purchase a vehicle. This might require a impromptu trip to wherever the vehicle is

on auction or available. We have \$5,929.70 left from the private donation after the SCBA and communication units are purchased to use towards this.

- RESCUE
 - We had 19 calls in August, we have had 17 thus far for September
 - The department is working on a pull out tray bed for the rear of the unit to help keep it more organized and allow us to plug items in to keep them powered up.
